Summary:

As an Accommodations Landscape Labourer, your role will be to assist with the upkeep and maintenance of all landscaped grounds areas associated with accommodations of Kokanee Springs Resort including the RV Park, Lodges, Villa, and Cabins to help to ensure that the property is always presented at the highest possible standards.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- To assist with the maintenance of all accommodation grounds areas. Including but not limited to, spring cleanup (gravel removal, sod repair), collection and disposal of litter, clean-up of fallen tree limbs and tree-related debris, mowing, trimming, and irrigation as required.
- To assist with the maintenance of accommodation grounds area-related gardens, planters, hanging baskets, irrigation systems, patios, sidewalks, other walkways and RV sites including weed control, cleanup of gravel and grass clippings, removal of encroaching shrub and tree branches and litter removal.
- To assist with the maintenance of accommodation grounds area drainage channels (dry streams) including weed control, removal of excess silt and soil build-up, and ensuring that pop-up drains and catch basins are clear and functioning.
- To assist with the maintenance of accommodation grounds areas with placed rocks, gravel or wood mulch including weed control and ensuring an overall tidy appearance.
- Safe operation and care of all accommodation grounds maintenance equipment including transport equipment, mowers, trimmers, blowers and hand tools.
- To perform multiple other tasks related to all aspects of the maintenance of the landscaped accommodations grounds emphasizing safe working procedures.
- To assist with non-landscape and garden-related duties as required (i.e. building and facilities cleaning).

Successful Candidates will possess the following:

- Related experience in high-end landscape and garden maintenance is a plus.
- Familiarity with resort operations is a plus.

- Being a golfer is a plus.
- This position is an outdoor job. An Accommodations Landscape Labourer must be able to work outdoors in many different types of weather conditions, be able to focus on the task at hand for 8-hour days and be physically capable of carrying out all landscape maintenance-related tasks such as repeatedly lifting 25kg objects as well as having the ability to stand, walk, kneel, bend or operate landscape maintenance tools or equipment for up to 8-hour shifts.
- Excellent interpersonal skills.
- Analytical skills; accurate; highly detail oriented.
- Organizational and time management skills.
- Strong oral communication skills.
- Valid driver's license (BC class 5 or equivalent) and transportation to work are required.
- Ability to work an 8:00 am to 4:30 pm shift and work at least one weekend day.
- Steel-toe boots are required.
- A variety of clothing is recommended, i.e. work gloves, and rain gear.
